Meeting Minutes:

- Ian led the discussion on making assignments for content creation within the powerpoint presentation.

 - o For assignment designations, review the document in Google Drive at the location above.
- The group discussed how in depth the training needs to get into a summary of pertinent cultural resources laws/regulations.
- Cultural resources awareness:
 - o Archaeological perspectives was determined to be redundant content
 - When to update AZSITE information topic was culled.
 - ASM site definitions was culled as content because that information is available on the ASM website
 - Need to include some high-level overview content on NRHP eligibility, integrity...etc.
 - Examples of success and problems associated with the use of AZSITE. This topic was elaborated on by Ian and Dan with the following suggested topics with assignees to compile content around them:
 - Road widening project, expanding existing facility (Branden)
 - New public/municipal development (Branden)
 - Utilities (Dan)
 - Master planning (lan)

- Gabe McGowan will get a meeting invite via Zoom sent out before the meeting.
- Gabe asked Dan and Ian about the change in the Governor's administration and how that may or may not effect the AZSITE advisory committee forming a board. Dan indicated that this should be a topic for the AZSITE Consortium for them to weigh in.

 - Dan recommended releasing it to others as part of a focus group and Gabe indicated he had already included some folks from ASU and ARO.
